## The Indian Chemical Society

The Indian Chemical Society, a premier Scientific Society of India, was founded in 1924, as National Forum for the community of chemists and members of allied disciplines in the country. The driving force behind its establishment was the nationalistic spirit prevailing in India under British rule. J. N. Mukherjee, J.C. Ghosh and S.S. Bhatnagar while carrying out their research work in the University College, London in 1919 for the D.Sc. Degree, took a decision that after coming back to India their endeavor would be to establish a Chemical Society like the Chemical Society of London. Their cherished dream was transformed into a reality with active cooperation of many of the leading personalities in the country, and the Indian Chemical Society was founded on May 9, 1924, as a registered Society, with Sir Prafulla Chandra Ray, the doyen of Indian Chemists, as the first President. Many of the distinguished personalities in the field of Chemical Science of that time in India took active interest in nurturing the new born Society.

## Seminar Theme

The Seminar intends to bring together the eminent scientists, technologists and young researchers from different parts of the country to provide a common platform for discussing their achievements and newer directions of research in the field of Chemical Sciences. The scientific program will consist of plenary sessions, invited talks, oral presentations by scholars, researchers, academicians and students.

## Call for Papers

Seminar papers are invited from scholars, researchers, academicians and students on the above mention theme. The sub-themes are only illustrative in nature and may include any paper covering the major theme of the seminar. Communication of acceptance will be sent to authors for presentation. Co-authorship is allowed, but each author is required to register and pay the registration fee individually.

## Abstraction Submission

Abstract must be written in English and in MS Word. Abstract of individual paper is to be submitted within the specified date as mentioned below and the following ordering is requested to be followed. Title of the paper, name of the author/Co-author, designation, institution, email, contact number within 300 words with maximum 5 key words. ## Full Paper Submission

Full paper of individual paper presenter is to be submitted within the specified date as mentioned below. The full paper for publication should contain Introduction, Review of Literature, Objectives, Methodology, Results and Discussion and Conclusion. References should be given at the end of the paper arranged alphabetically by authors followed by the year of publication, title of the paper, name of the Journal/book, publisher, volume, and relevant pages in succession. ## Accommodation

## Climate of Kokrajhar
