# 8. To declare the results of the Election of The Indian Chemical Society held in the year 2022.

The Honorary Secretary reported that the election of the Office Bearers and the Members of the Council (2023-2025) had been conducted both by Postal Ballots and Online Voting successfully. At this point Professor G.D. Yadav, President congratulated all the members of the Election Committee and Professor D.C. Mukherjee, Returning Officer in particular for conducting the Election successfully. The Honorary Secretary then requested Professor D.C. Mukherjee to declare the results of the Election.
