

Education in Chemical Science and Technology

GUIDELINES FOR AUTHORS

Education in Chemical Science and Technology is a peer reviewed Periodical which publishes full length research papers, short communications, review articles and book reviews covering all areas of Chemical Sciences and allied fields.

(1) Manuscript Preparation:

- a) Page Layout: A4 (21 cm × 29.7 cm) leaving 2.5 cm margin on all sides of the text. All the text should be in Times New Roman font, double spaced and pages should be numbered consecutively.
- b) Use MS word for text. The preferred file formats for figures are TIFF, JPEG, EPS etc. with high resolution.
- c) The first page should contain title in bold (14 font size), names of authors in bold (12 font size), affiliation's address (11 font size) of each author and email id of the corresponding author (11 font size), abstract within 200 words (11 font size), 3 to 5 keywords (11 font size).
- d) Main Text-The paper should be divided into the following sections in the sequence:

Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results and Discussion, Conclusion, Acknowledgement and References.

Tables and Figures (good resolution, 600 dpi) should be numbered consecutively and given in the order of their appearance in the text and should not be given on separate pages.

- e) References: References should be cited in the text as superscript numbers in order of appearance.

References at the end of the paper should be listed in serial order to match their order of appearance in the text. Names of journals should be in italics and volume number should be in bold.

Reference to papers e.g. R.S. Ganesh, S. Pravin and T.P. Rao, 2005, *Talanta*, **66**, 513.

Reference to books e.g. J.D. Lee, 1984, "A New Course in Inorganic Chemistry", ELBS and Van Nostrand Reinhold (UK) Co. Ltd. (3rd Eddn.), p.268-269.

- f) Abbreviations should be explained at first appearance in the text.
- g) Nomenclature should be as per **IUPAC** guidelines.

- h) SI units should be used throughout.
- i) A short running text Bio-data (within 100 words) with passport size photograph (soft copy) of each author must be sent along with the manuscript.

(2) Manuscript Submission

Manuscript with a cover letter should be submitted online at ics.correspondence@gmail.com

The paper will be accepted for publication after review.

Galley proofs will be sent online to the corresponding author and should be returned to the Editorial office within seven working days.
