At the outset, the Honorary Secretary requested Professor R.N. Prasad, President to preside over the meeting. Professor Prasad took the chair and called the meeting to order. He welcomed the members present and sought the cooperation of the members and then requested Professor D.C. Mukherjee, the Honorary Secretary to take up the agenda items of the meeting.

The Honorary Secretary conveyed his sincere thanks to the Chair and also welcomed the members present. He then placed the items of the agenda.

Agenda -1

To confirm the Proceedings of the last Annual General Meeting of the Society held at the JECRC University, Jaipur, Rajasthan on December 29, 2015.

The Honorary Secretary reported that the Proceedings of the last Annual General Meeting of the Society held at the JECRC University, Jaipur, Rajasthan on December 29, 2015, had been circulated to all members and he did not receive any comments on the proceedings.

Professor R.N. Prasad, the President of the Meeting asked opinions of the Members whether the recording of the proceedings was correct.
