As directed by the Council, as per provision in Sec. 10 (b) in Part III of Bye- Law II, proposals are invited from the Fellows of the Society in good-standing for filling up the vacancies in the Council (Office-Bearers and Ordinary Members of the Council). Proposal Forms for submission of proposals for filling the vacancies are enclosed. Please write **"Proposals"** on the envelope containing your Proposal Forms and send the same so that it may reach the office of the Society on or before September 30, 2022. In this connection your kind attention is drawn to the following:

- 1) The Proposal Form must be duly filled in and completed in all respects, otherwise it may be rejected.
- 2) **Correct Fellowship Number of the proposer, seconder and the persons proposed must be quoted in the Proposal Form at the proper places.**
- 3) A CTS Bank Draft/Multicity CTS Cheque or **online** of Rs.1000 for each post of Office-Bearer and Ordinary Member of the Council on any bank at Kolkata is to be issued in favour of **Indian Chemical Society** should be sent along with the proposal form(s) for each of the vacancies for which proposals are submitted or the persons proposed may be requested to send the amount to the Society. **The CTS Bank Draft/Multicity CTS Cheque should reach the office of the Society on or before October 15, 2022 or by online (remittance receipt must be attached) State Bank of India, Manicktala (Calcutta) Branch, A/c Number: 11152790242, Branch Code: 1715, IFSC: SBIN001715, MICR: 700002062.**
- 4) Each contestant shall get a voter list free of cost.

Attention of the Fellows is also drawn to the following :

**Bye-Law II, Part III. Sec. 10(c) :**

"Each nomination shall be duly proposed by at least one Fellow and seconded by another and shall inter alia contain the qualifications, official designation, address, and a brief statement of the experience of the person nominee. The consent of the nominee should either accompany the nomination or reach the Honorary Secretary within seven days after the last date for submitting the nomination; otherwise the nomination shall be invalid."

The duly filled in Proposal Form must accompany with a passport size photograph of the person nominated.

**Art. IV, Sec. 5(a) of the Constitution :**

"5(a). Only the Fellows of the Society, who have been duly admitted shall have privilege of voting at any meeting of the Society, and to contest and be elected to any of the Offices or the Council of the Society."

**Note :** All other Fellows are eligible to contest in the election in accordance to the provisions ( as given below) in the Constitution of the Society.

Article VIII of the Constitution (Considering the amendments made in the Annual General Meeting dated 13.12.2021)

Sec. 1(a). The President shall hold office for three years from 1st January following the Annual General Meeting at which he is so elected. If the Annual General Meeting is delayed by any reason, he will hold the office immediately after the Annual General Meeting in which is so elected.

(b). The President after holding Office for a period of 3 years from 1st January following the Annual General Meeting in which he is so elected shall be eligible for re-election for only one more term. If he does not seek re-election immediately after the expiry of his first term, he can contest for the post of President for one term in his lifetime. In the interim period he becomes an Advisor till he becomes the president for the second term. He will not contest for any of the posts of the Council after the expiry of the second term as the President. After the completion of the second term, he will remain the Advisor. It will not be effective for the Advisors who had elected in the election held in 2016 (i.e.

hold the Office from January 01, 2017) and earlier.

Sec. 2(a). The Vice-President, like the President, shall hold office for a period of three years.

(b). He will be eligible for re-election to the post of Vice-President only for one more term. A Vice-President can hold this office only for two terms in lifetime.

Sec. 3(a). The Honorary Secretary shall hold office for a period of three years from 1st January following the Annual General Meeting in which he is elected and shall be eligible for only one more term in his lifetime.

(b). The Honorary Secretary must be a resident of the Headquarters of the Society.

Sec. 4(a). The Honorary Treasurer shall hold office for a period of three years from 1st January following the Annual General Meeting in which he is elected and shall be eligible for only one more term in his lifetime.

(b). The Honorary Treasurer must be a resident of the Headquarters of the Society.

Sec. 6(a). The tenure of the Ordinary Members of the Council shall be three years after which they shall not be eligible for re-election as Ordinary Members of the Council until after the lapse of at least three years. Any Member can seek election to the post of Ordinary Member of the Council only for two terms in his lifetime.
